4. PARTICIPANTS:

The summon will be open. All athletes complying with the registration requirements established in the Official Announcement will be able to participate.

In the FILA Cadets category a weight loss will not be allowed. In the event of a variation in the division, the only allowable change will be to a division immediately above the original weight category.

Athlete's participation in an upper category:

The participation of athletes in an immediate upper category will be authorized according to the regulations of the International Wrestling Association only if the following requirements are met:

In the FILA Cadets category they can only participate if they have turned 15 years old.

In the FILA Junior World category they will be able to participate if they have turned 17 years old.

Must submit a Medical Certificate.

Submit a written permit signed by parents or tutors stating that there is no pre-existing condition which would impede an athlete from participating in a higher weight division.

No athlete is entitled to carry out any other endeavor within the MexGames.

5. REGISTRATIONS:

According to the Official Announcement.

The Official Announcement will be open from February 1st to March 11th, 2016 via the website: www.mexgames.com.

The documents needed to complete the registration will be received by the Organizing Committee before March 1st, 2016. PLEASE NOTE: The registration process through www.mexgames.com does not guarantee your enrollment in the event. Enrollment will be subject to the receipt and verification of all required documents by the Organizing Committee. All documents listed in the official announcement must be turned in to the Organizing Committee by the stated date.

5.1 DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR THE REGISTRATION OF ATHLETES.

- Original or copy of the Mexican Birth Certificate. In the event of not having one of these items, the copy or original of the Mexican Birth Certificate of their mother/father or grandmother/grandfather will be accepted.
- American citizens will be able to submit a copy of: their parent's or grandparent's Birth Certificate or Letter of Naturalization as a proof of their Mexican citizenship.
- Two Current ID size photographs (2).
- Copy of an ID with a photograph.
- Registration Form.
- Athletes Liability Waiver Letter.
- USA Wrestling Card (If you do not have this document, please contact Mark Trice, Technical Director of Wrestling, at mtrice@csaprepstar.com or Jeff Duva at jeff@csaprepstar.com).
- If the athlete is under 18 years old, in order to authorize their participation, a signed letter from their parents or tutors will be required.

Classifications will run from first to last place (third places will be awarded) in each division, category and gender.

8. UNIFORM:

It is compulsory for athletes to wear a blue and red official uniform printed on the front with the logo of their association or the equivalent, no bigger than 7 cm x 7 cm; on the back the official abbreviation of the association or equivalent no bigger than 10 cm x 10 cm. It must also contain a print of the first letter of their name and the surname in a semicircle over the abbreviation of the association or equivalent represented by each athlete no bigger than 7 cm x 7 cm; special wrestling shoes are compulsory. Non-compliant athletes will be disqualified.

9. REGULATION:

International Wrestling Federation (FILA) regulations in force.

10. TRAINERS:

Will be appointed by each team or equivalent and must be included in the registration format.

No trainer is entitled to carry out any other endeavor within the MexGames.

11. JUDGES:

Judges will be availed and appointed by the Organizing Committee.

No Referee, Official or Judge is entitled to carry out any other endeavor within the MexGames.

12. ADDS, REMOVALS AND SUBSTITUTIONS:

12.1 ADDS: Not allowed once the registration period has concluded.

12.2 REMOVALS: Positions of removed athletes will be forfeited.

12.3 SUBSTITUTIONS: Only one substitution will be allowed by category, gender and style for athletes that have suffered a lesion which has been justified by a medical certificate.

13. CONTROL OF THE COMPETITION AREA:

Access to competition and weigh-in areas will only be allowed to the personnel accredited by the Organizing Committee. Common shoes will not be allowed in these areas. Athletes and trainers will be allowed in the competition area only during their corresponding combat. When finished they must leave the area.

14. PRELIMINARY MEETING:

The Preliminary Meeting will be held after the official weigh-in where information issues will be discussed. The meeting will be chaired by one representative of the Organizing Committee and one representative from the United States Wrestling Federation, trainers or representatives. Final details will be announced at this event.

15. JURY OF APPEALS:

Amendments to international regulations do not provide for the installation of a Jury of Appeals.

16. COMPETITION PROGRAM

Will be announced by the personnel in charge of technical issues related to the competition during the Preliminary Meeting.
